Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company (HDCC), Inc., on behalf of the Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command (NAVFAC) Hawaii, will start work on the Waiawa Navy Waterline Project for Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam on August 12, 2019.

This phase will entail erection and travel of a lattice boom crane for the placement of the waterline in the vicinity of the Sandwich Isle Pest Control. The task will take two days to complete and will occupy space in the culde-sac. Please be aware that traffic in the general area will be limited or delayed. Additionally, there will be access and parking restrictions. Residents, businesses and motorists near the project site are asked to observe all traffic signs, anticipate/plan for the possible delays, and drive with caution.
